Food and Treats

- Canned cat and dog food (Wellness, Nutro or Science Diet brands)

- Wheatena original toasted wheat cereal for our wildlife patients
- Dog biscuits and hot dogs for dog training

Comfort and Care

- Gently used or new towels, blankets and sheets
- Leashes (six-foot, medium width, non-retractable nylon only)
- Martingale-style dog collars (medium size)
- Soft, washable cat toys and laser pointers
- Mentally-stimulating dog toys, including Puzzle Cube® and Kongs®
- Headlamps for night-time dog walking (avail. at sporting goods stores)

Animal Health

- Cat litter (unscented, non-clumping litter only)
- Vicks® liquid vapo-steam
- Quick read digital thermometers designed for small animals
- Latex exam gloves (all sizes)
- Baby wipes
- Surgical headlamp, cable and illuminator
- Incubators to keep baby animals warm
- Pharmaceutical scale

Kids Education

- Small or youth size non-leather gardening gloves
- Mini voice recorder (for animal sounds)
- Animal theme stickers
- Construction paper, colored markers, and glue sticks
- Yarn and fleece material

Equipment and Other Needs

- Gift cards to home improvement stores, grocery stores, and Costco
- Plastic dust pans and brooms, and battery-charged DustBusters
- 10-gallon aquariums with tight fitting lids
- Garden hose reels and water hoses
- Shallow plastic kiddie pools for water-loving wildlife
- Handheld mirrors so single birds don't feel alone
- Wooden or metal benches for adoption visiting yard
- Laminator for letter/legal pages and/or laminating pouches
- Small microwave for heating fluids and warming discs
- Freezer thermometers
