



Donation Drive Host Information

1. Get the Word Out – Tell everyone you know about your PAWS Donation Drive!

- Send e-mails to your friends, family and co-workers about the needs of the animals at PAWS and include donation drive details.
- E-mail the PAWS Wish List as an attachment – this will allow each person the opportunity to pass it along to everyone in their address book too.
- Post the PAWS Wish List in high traffic areas of your office or organization– or distribute one in everyone’s mailbox.
- Make a formal announcement during a department meeting, or invite a PAWS member to speak about our life-saving work to your group.
- Get creative – there are many more ideas out there that will help get your friends and co-workers excited about your gift drive. And you can always call PAWS staff for additional tips.

2. Determine Your Collection Area

- Collect the donations in a high-traffic area. People can choose to either purchase the items listed on the PAWS Wish List or select a dollar amount and write a check. All checks should be made payable to PAWS.
- PAWS will send acknowledgment letters for every monetary donation, and can provide a receipt for product donations as well. Please have the donor write their name, address, phone number and e-mail address, along with the items they’ve donated on a slip of paper then deliver that information to PAWS with your collected donations.

3. Deliver Your Donations to PAWS!

- Directions and drop-off locations are listed on the reverse of this page. All donated items and check should be delivered directly to PAWS in Lynnwood.

4. Celebrate Your Success!

- Congratulate yourself and everyone who participated in your donation drive. Thank everyone who supported your efforts. You just made many new friends for the homeless injured and orphaned animals at PAWS!

Directions

From Northbound I-5 or I-405

Take the exit for State Route 525 (the Mukilteo Speedway). Take SR 525 north and west until it intersects Highway 99 via an overpass. Continue on 525 a block past 99 to the first light at Lincoln Way and turn right and then turn right again onto Southbound 99. Go a few blocks to 148th and turn right and proceed west a few blocks to 44th Ave. W. Turn left on 44th and proceed south. Look for the PAWS sign on the east side of the street.

From Southbound I-5

Take the 128th Street exit in South Everett, head west on 128th Street. Head west until you reach Highway 99. Turn left onto 99 and continue to head south until 148th Street. Turn right on 148th and go down the hill. Turn left onto 44th Avenue West. PAWS is several blocks down and on the left.

From Northbound Highway-99

If you are coming north on Highway 99, continue north to 148th SW, just past the Safeway, turn left, and left again on 44th Ave W. You will see the PAWS sign on the east side of the street.
